- Experience with and understanding of generator operation and maintenance, small engine repairs, 12/24-volt wiring troubleshooting, general building maintenance and basic plumbing. Knowledge on chilling systems will be an asset.

- Working 5 days on and 2 days off. Available to be on call when necessary.
- Reliable transportation to commute to and from work. A valid Driver's license.
